

Jacob's Ladder is a faith-based 9-month scholarship program to prepare seniors for post-secondary success as well as support current academic studies. Jacob's Ladder is a program of the Care Center located in Loveland, OH.



### What are the commitments?

Jacob's Ladder is a 60-hour program. This includes 20 hours of group learning and discussion, 20 hours of mentoring with coaches, and 20 hours of community building & service.

#### What are the benefits?

College success skills, ACT preparation, academic support, college access support, college visits, and financial aid/scholarship application assistance are just some of the benefits of the Jacob's Ladder program. Upon successful completion of the program students will also receive a \$3,000 scholarship.

# What are the main components of Jacob's Ladder?

The 3 C's of Jacob's Ladder include:

<u>Classes</u>: there are 3 main topic areas classes cover: college prep, life skills, and spiritual & personal growth.

<u>Coaching</u>: each student will be paired with a coach. The coach is there to walk alongside the student through the college transition process. Coaches are also there to be support and encouragement through the student's current life circumstances. They are there to provide emotional, spiritual, and academic support. Coaches are there to help students find THEIR path.

<u>Community Building & Service</u>: In the fall there will be a weekend retreat to build community amongst the Jacob's Ladder participants & coaches (date TBD), as well as 2-3 community service events throughout the school year (likely on a Saturday morning).

## When and where do we meet?

Jacob's Ladder will begin on August 30<sup>th</sup>, 2021 and continue through mid-May, meeting every other Monday evening from 6-8:30pm at Northstar Church in Loveland. Dinner is provided for the students during these meetings. In addition, there will be a community building weekend retreat in the fall and 2-3 Community Service events throughout the year.

# Do we do anything anything else?

Pending approval of your application, the Jacob's Ladder Program Director will set up interviews with each student so that we can pair them with a suitable coach. The program will officially kick off in September:
